

Calls For Art Submissions to Harlin's 46th Annual Fall Art Show Competition



The Harlin Museum of West Plains, MO is set to host its 46th Annual Fall Art Show this year and is calling for art submissions from all Ozarks regional artists. Entry dates for the show's juried competition will be Friday, October 15th and Saturday, October 16th from 12pm-4pm at the museum. The show's entries will be on display in the museum's Hathcock Gallery, October 10th – October 31st, 2020.

Categories and divisions for this juried competition art show will include **Fine Arts (2D & 3D entries)** for *novice*, *advanced* or *youth divisions*, and **Digital Arts (Still or Animated)** for *adult* or *youth divisions*. The show's final categories will be determined by the entries received. All entries will be evaluated for design/composition, technique/skill of

construction, presentation, and creativity/originality. Entries must meet given guidelines and pass jury standards for acceptance into the competition portion of the show.

The award for Best Of Show will receive a \$500 award donated by show sponsor, West Plains, Savings & Loan.

Entry Dates: Friday, October 15th & Saturday, October 16th, 2021 (12 pm - 4 pm) at the Harlin Museum's Hathcock Gallery, located at 405 Worcester Ave, West Plains, MO, 65775

Entry Fee: 1 entry - \$9.00; 2 entries - \$13.00, 3 entries - \$17.00, 4 entries - \$20. Enter 4 pieces; get 5th entry FREE! Limit 5 entries per artist. Cash, check, or card; make checks payable to the Harlin Museum.

Categories: Amount of entries will determine categories;

All 2-D & 3-D art will be accepted for consideration, including: paintings in oil; water mediums (includes: acrylic, gouache, regular watercolor and watercolor pencils); mixed medium; collage/papercraft; drawings in pastel; graphics (includes: pencil, graphite, charcoal, ink, linocut, & colored pencil); digital art; original wood burning art; carved wooden/metal wall hangings & free-standing sculpture; other acceptable forms of sculpture*: wood, clay, ceramic, metal, & papier mache.

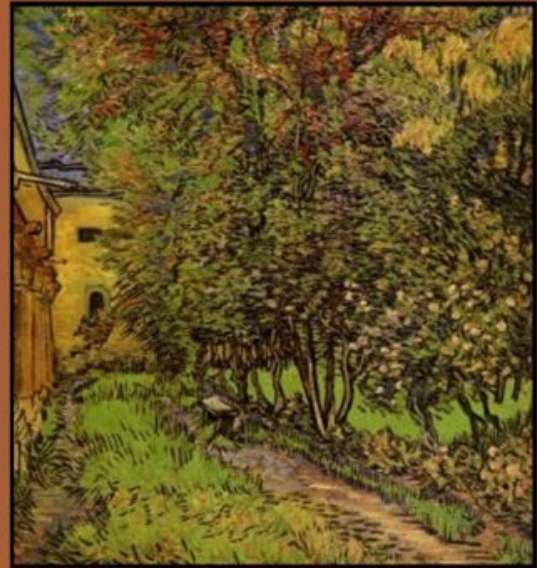
Cash prizes to be awarded to winners of 1st - 3rd place.; \$500 will be awarded to winner of Best Of Show. Also to be included are special honor awards and special online category awards chosen by the public.

Guidelines: All pieces must be original works of the artist entering. **No Copies.** All work must have been done in the last 4 years and not been previously shown in a Harlin Museum Art Competition. All paintings must be either framed or 1.25" gallery wrapped canvas with wire and eye-screws for hanging. **No Saw-tooth Hangers.** All pieces must be dry. *All sculpture must be free-standing or be accompanied by any necessary display equipment.

Size Limit: Framed pieces, no larger than 36 X 72 in. (this includes the support base for sculptures).

This will be a juried event. Entries must meet guidelines during the juried portion of the entry process for acceptance into the competition. All entries will be judged using a point-based evaluation system that grades four areas: design/composition, technique/skill of construction, presentation, and creativity/originality; prizes will be awarded to the entries receiving the highest scores in succession.

Pieces will be released (at approximately 3pm) on Sunday, November 7th, and must be picked up from the museum within the following week, during regular hours of operation, or possession will be forfeited to the museum .
