Awards are given for Best of Show, 1st Place, 2nd Place, and 3rd Place entries in each category of both adult & youth divisions. People's Choice.is awarded by popular vote.

Entry Dates: Friday, August 19 & Saturday, August 20, 2022 (12 pm - 4 pm each day) in the Harlin Museum's Hathcock Gallery, located at 405 Worcester Ave, West Plains, MO, 65775

Entry Fee: All entries are \$5.00 each; enter 5 for \$20.00. We accept cash, check, or debit/credit card; make checks payable to Harlin Museum.

<u>Multimedia Categories:</u> Examples of some of the art forms we hope to see represented:

Paintings & Drawings

(Watercolor, Oil, Acrylic, Pastels, Charcoal, Pen & Ink)

Photography

(Color, B&W, etc.)

Collage & Papercraft

(2D or 3D)

Sculpture

(Clay, Ceramic, Stonework, Papier-mâché, etc.)

Models

(Scale models, military models, matchstick models, working models, etc.)

<u>Guidelines:</u> All entries will be evaluated on their individual application of technical skill as well as how skillfully they represent "the Ozarks" and to convey through art the essence of the 2022 theme: Ozark Waterways.

All entries must be original works of the artist entering. Digital enhancement and/or editing is allowed in all photography entries, but must be noted on the entry form at the time of entry to the competition. All frameable works must be ready with wire and eye-screws on the back for hanging.

No Saw-tooth Hangers, please. All non-frameable entries must be either free-standing or come accompanied with any display articles needed for proper presentation.

All presentation articles will be returned at the conclusion of the exhibit. There are no size requirements or limitations for this competition.

Any entry that portrays or otherwise includes inappropriate and/or offensive content, including violence, human or animal based violation, etc. are strictly prohibited and will not be accepted to this exhibit.

Competition pieces will be released for pickup beginning Sunday, September 18, 2022 and owners must arrange to pick up entries from the museum by the Sunday of the following week; unclaimed entries become property of the museum.

<u>Sales:</u> Entries may be offered for sale during the dates of the show; the museum receives commission from all sales made during this time (sales split—70% to artist/30% to museum).
